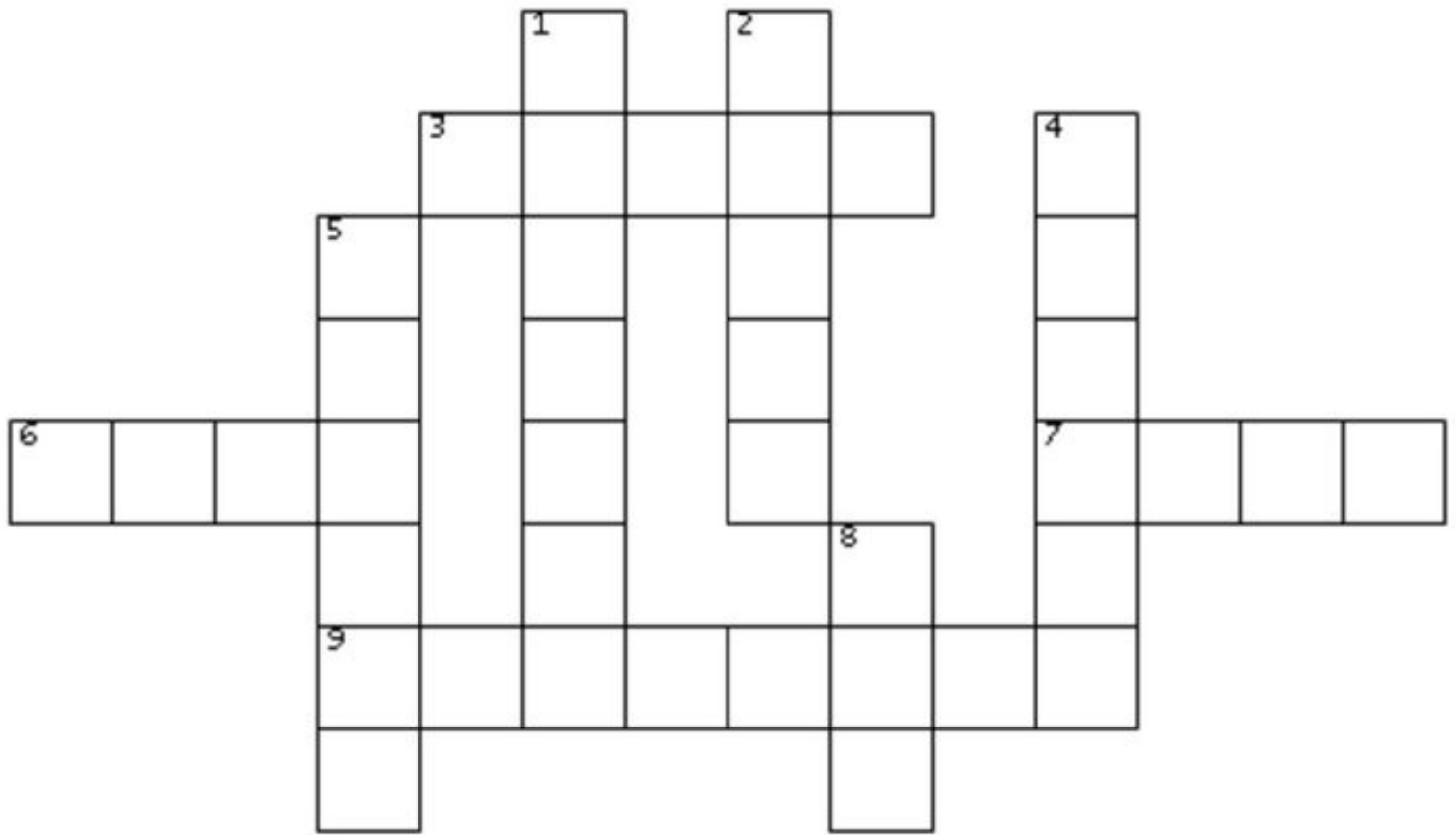


Animals Crossword



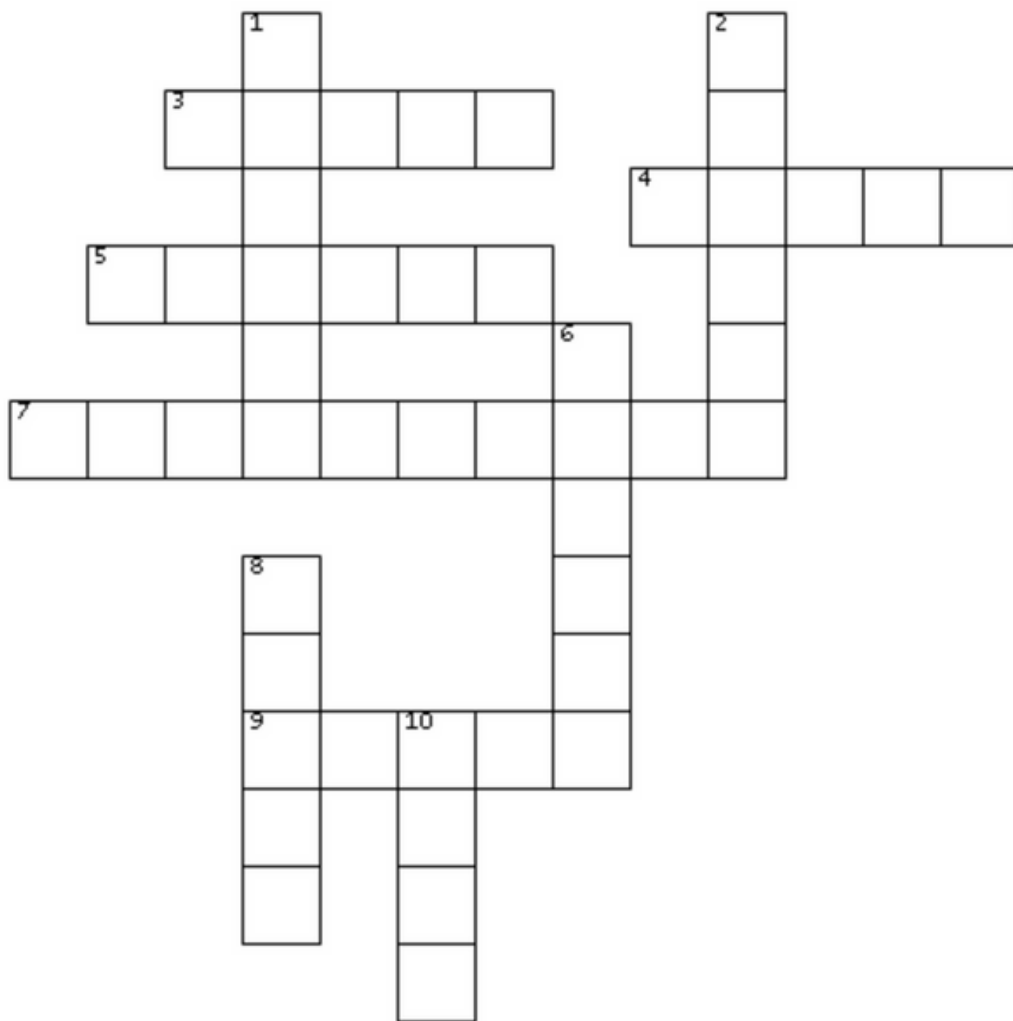
ACROSS

Fruits Crossword



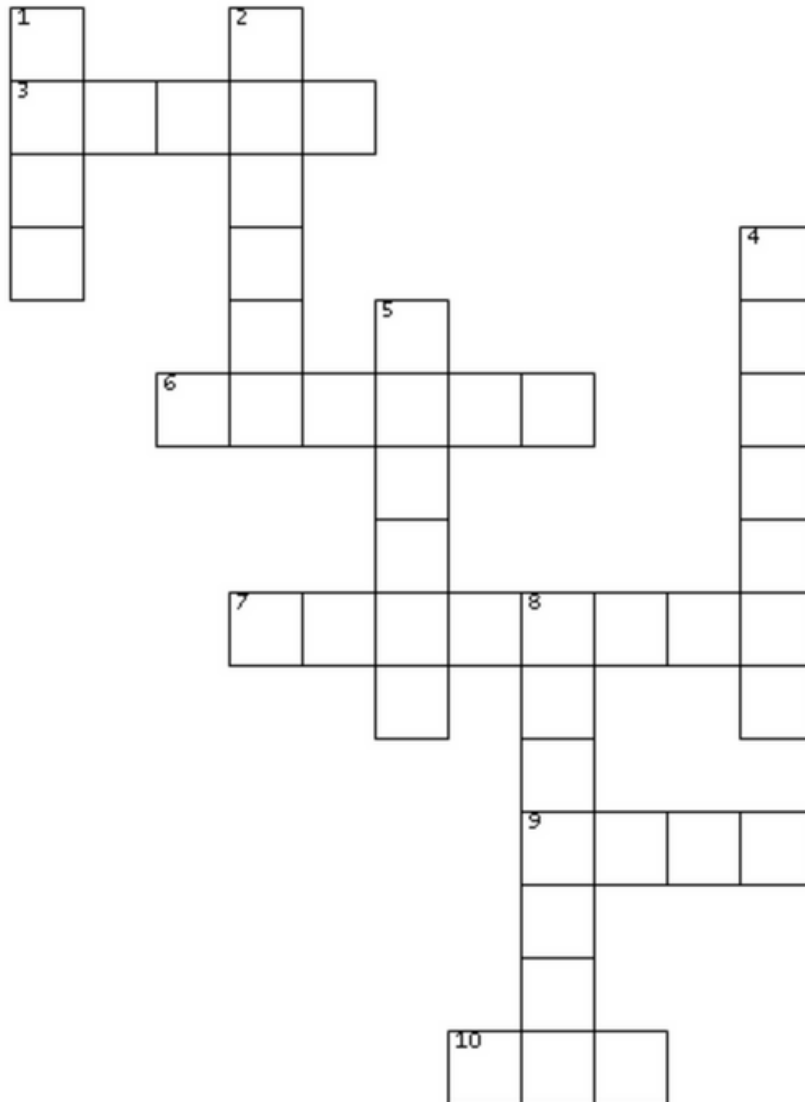
ACROSS

Vegetables Crossword



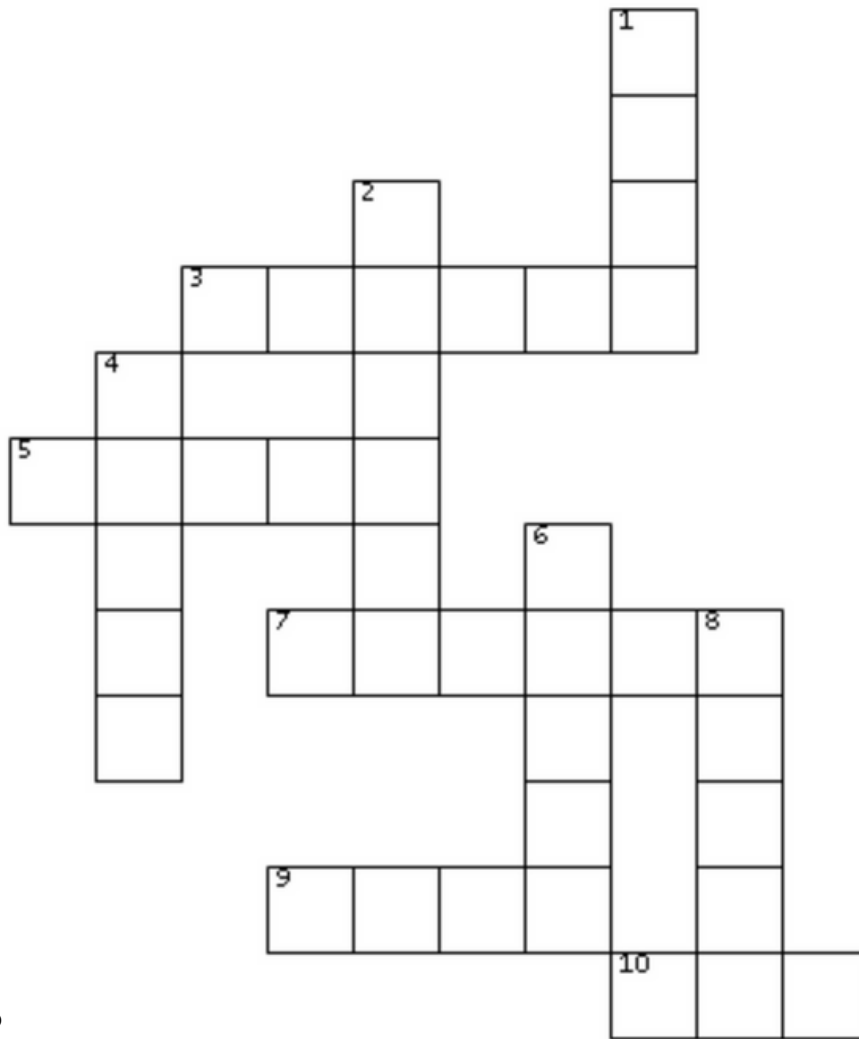
ACROSS

Colors Crossword



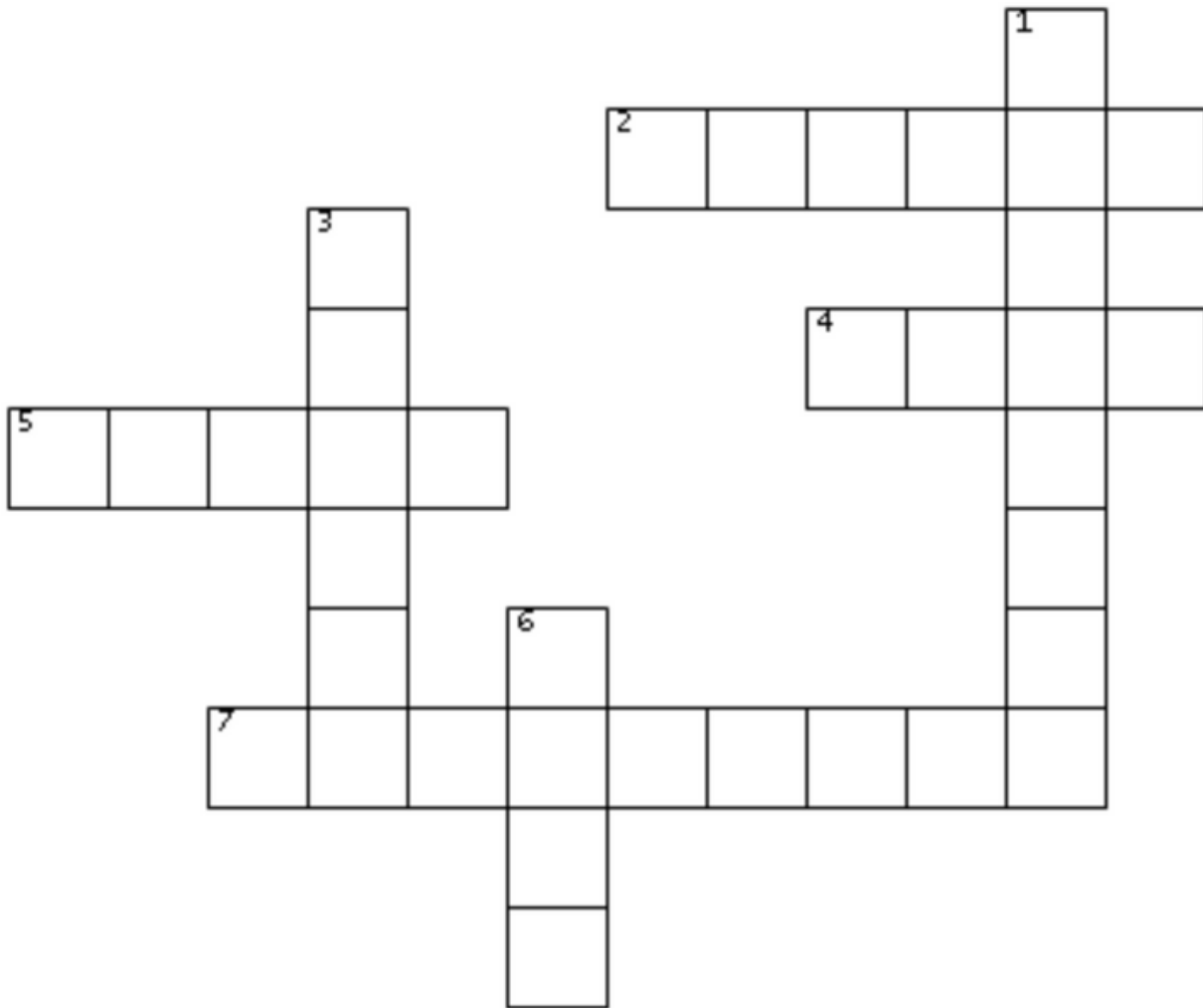
ACROSS

Shapes Crossword



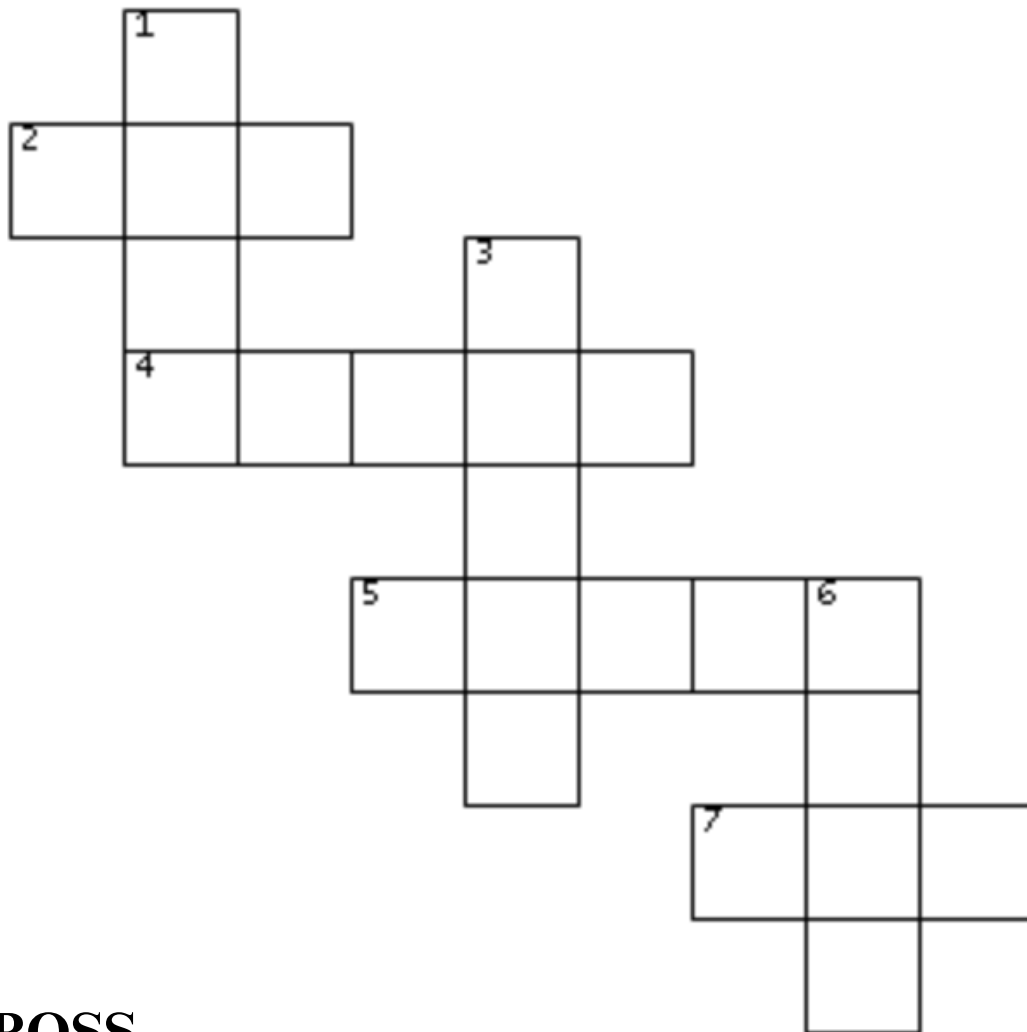
ACROSS

Numbers Crossword



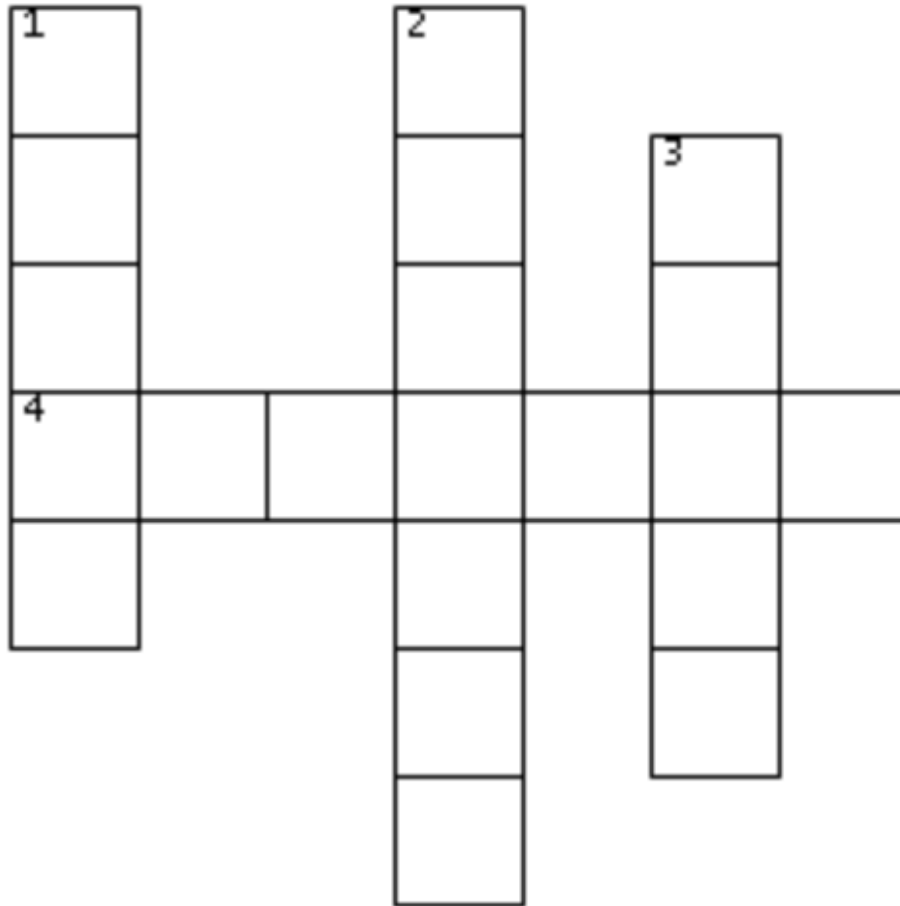
ACROSS

4. – Colorful arc seen after rain.

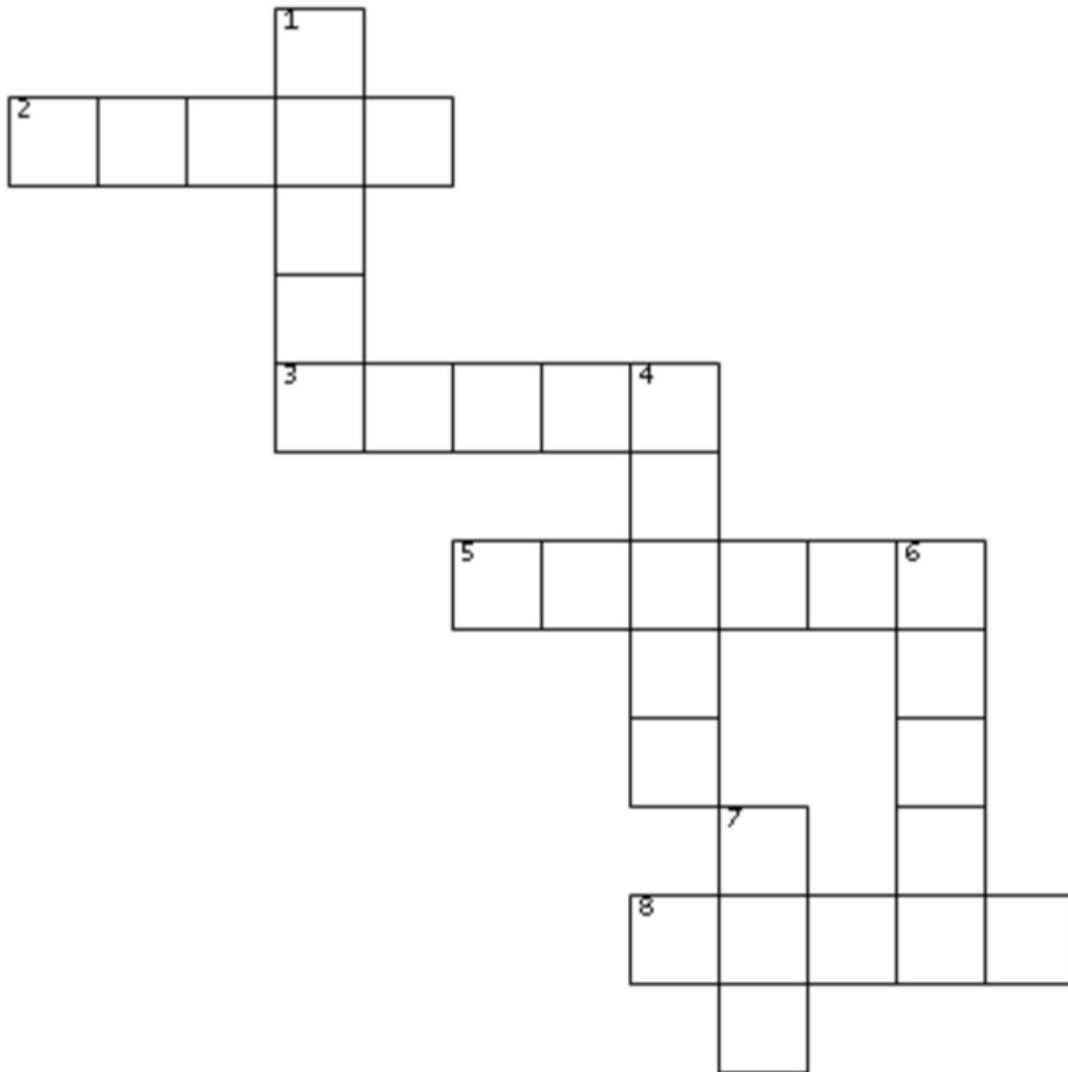
DOWN

Clothes Crossword



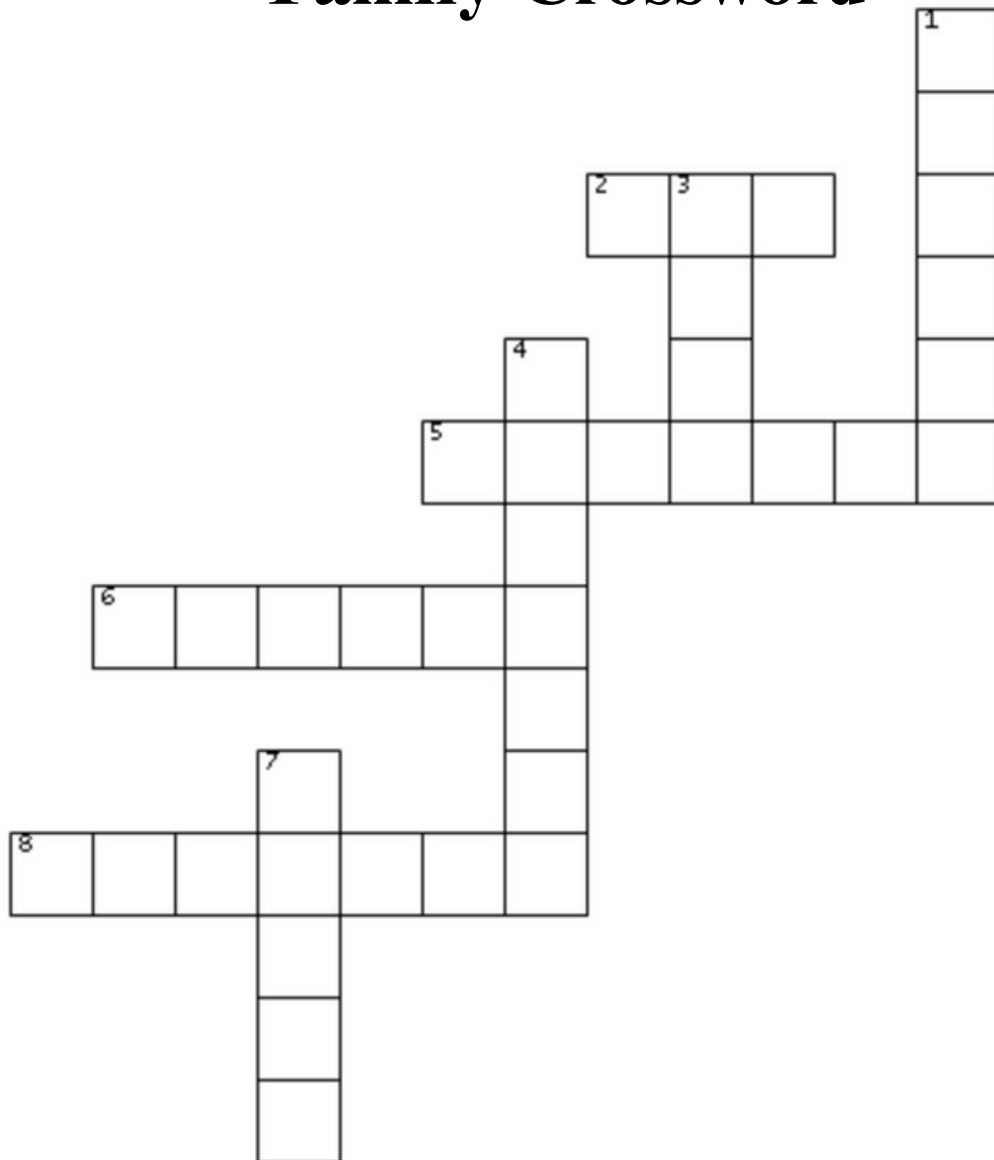
ACROSS

Family Crossword



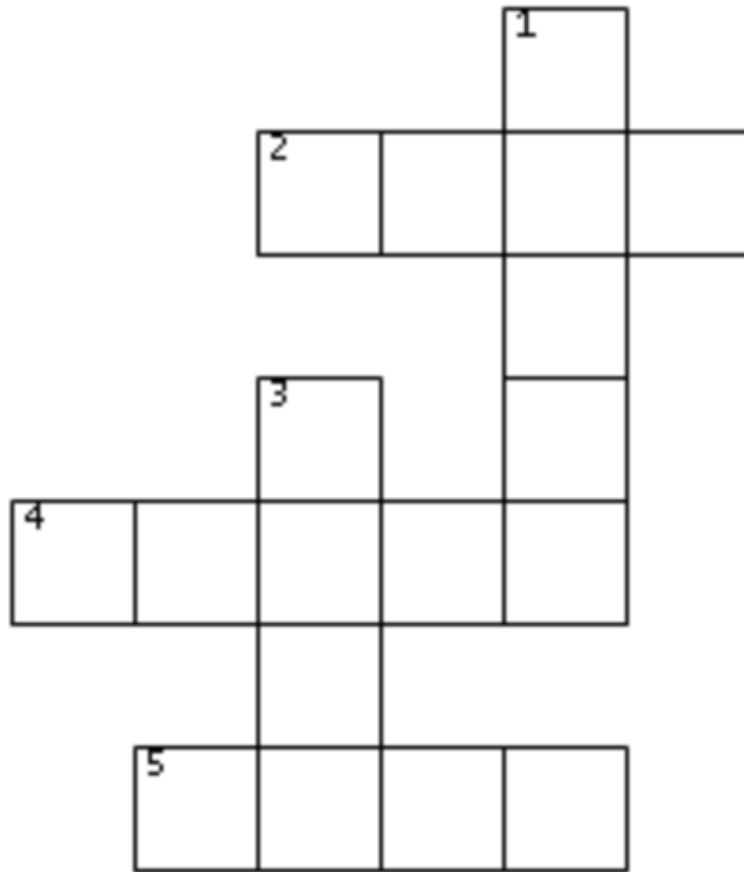
ACROSS

Body Parts Crossword



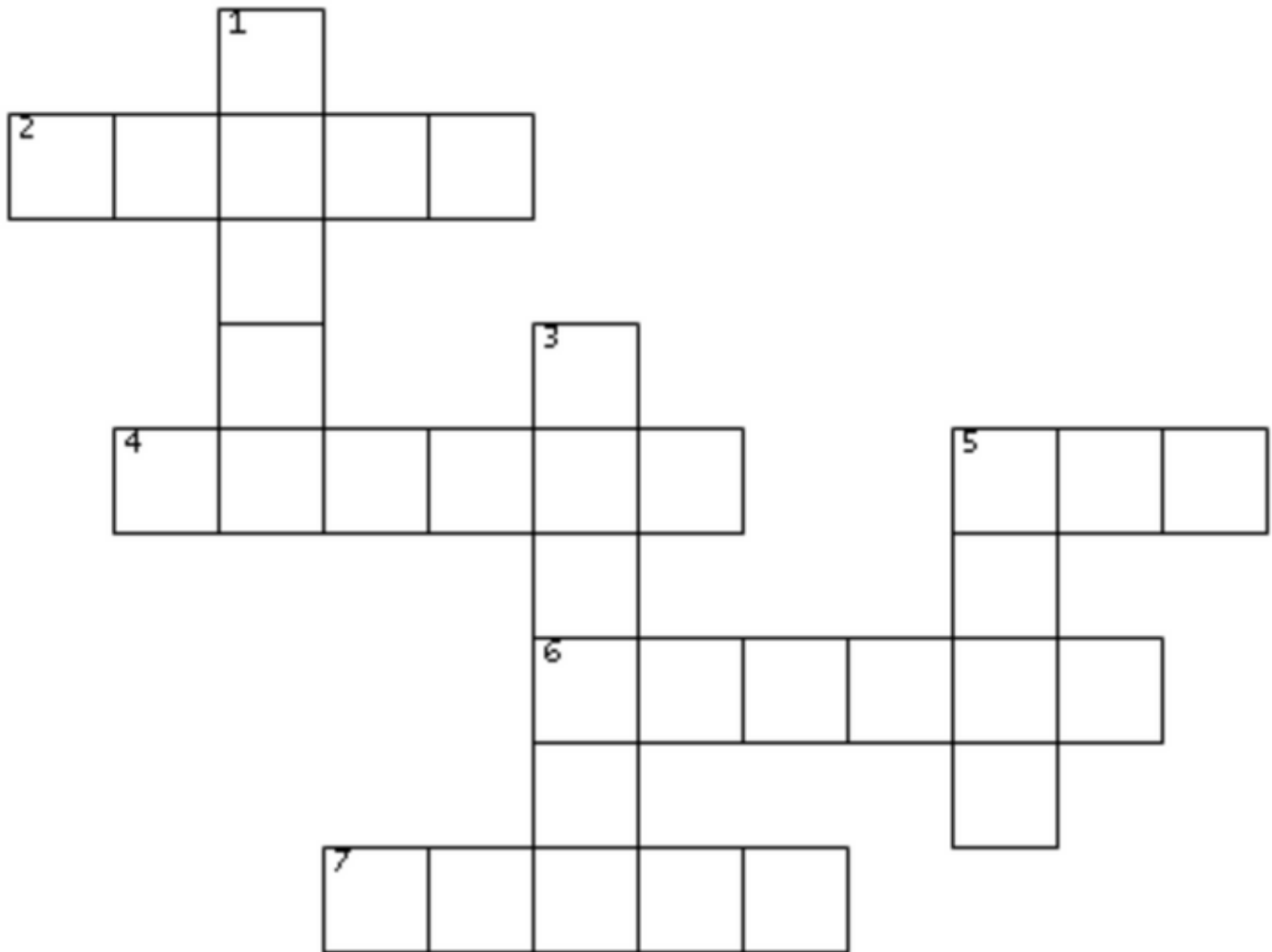
ACROSS

School Supplies Crossword



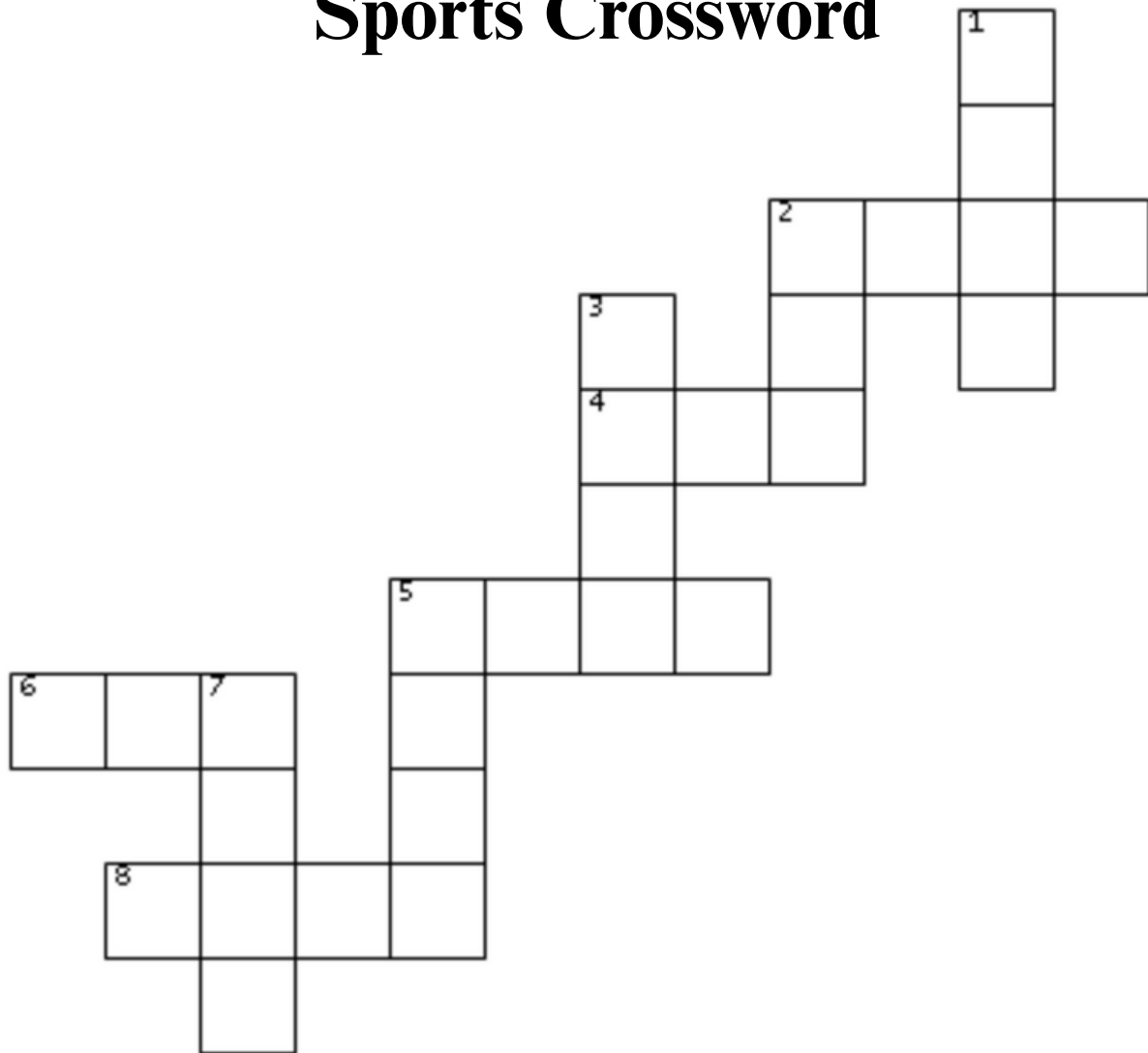
ACROSS

Sports Crossword



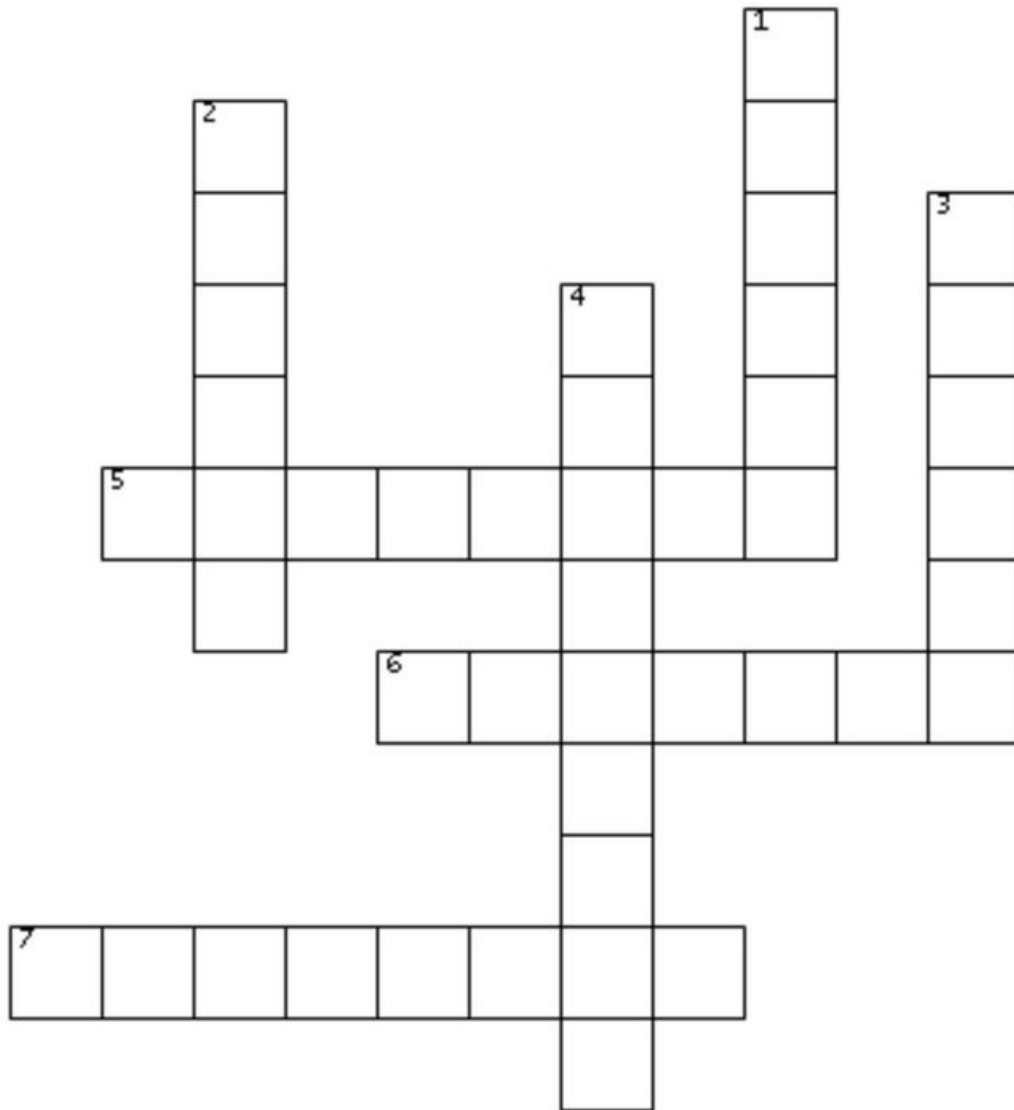
ACROSS

Days of the Week Crossword



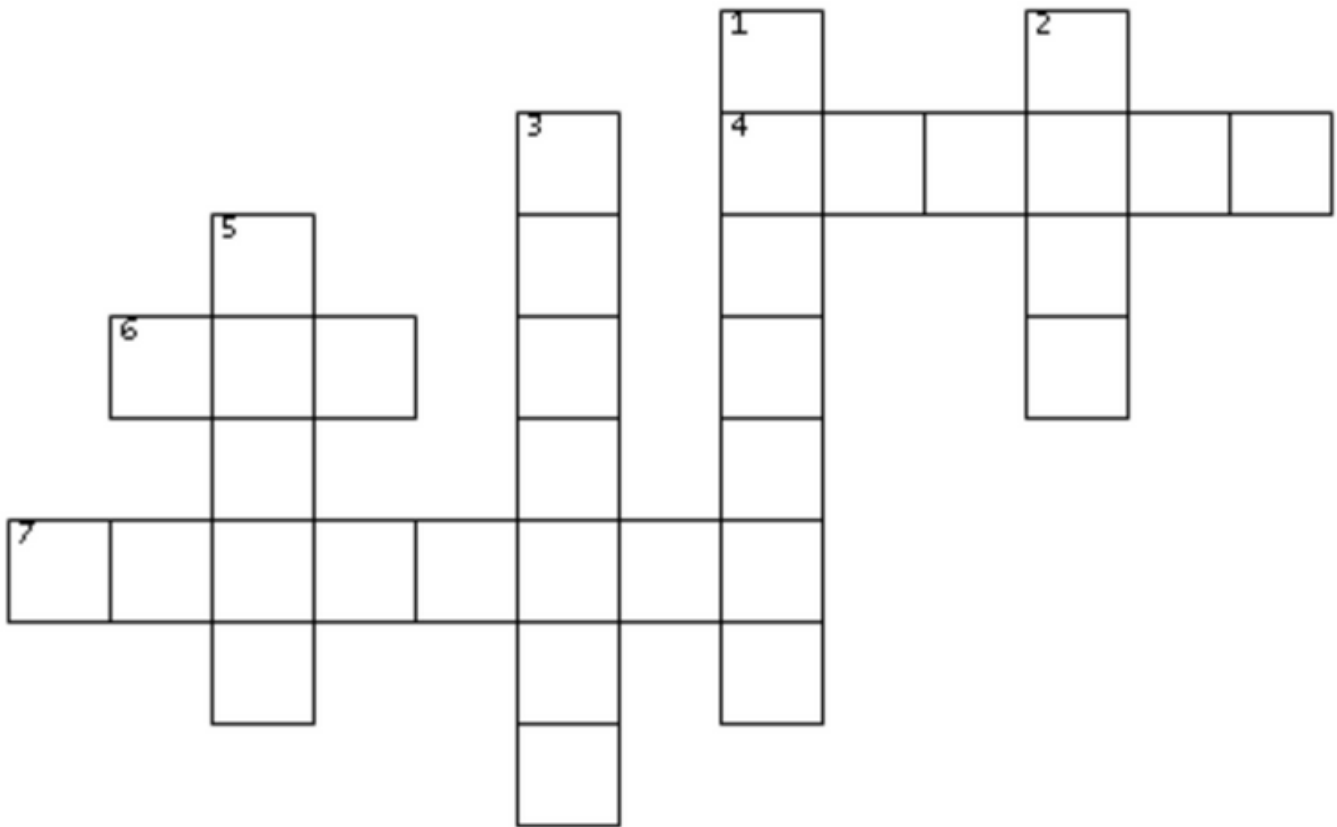
ACROSS

Months Crossword



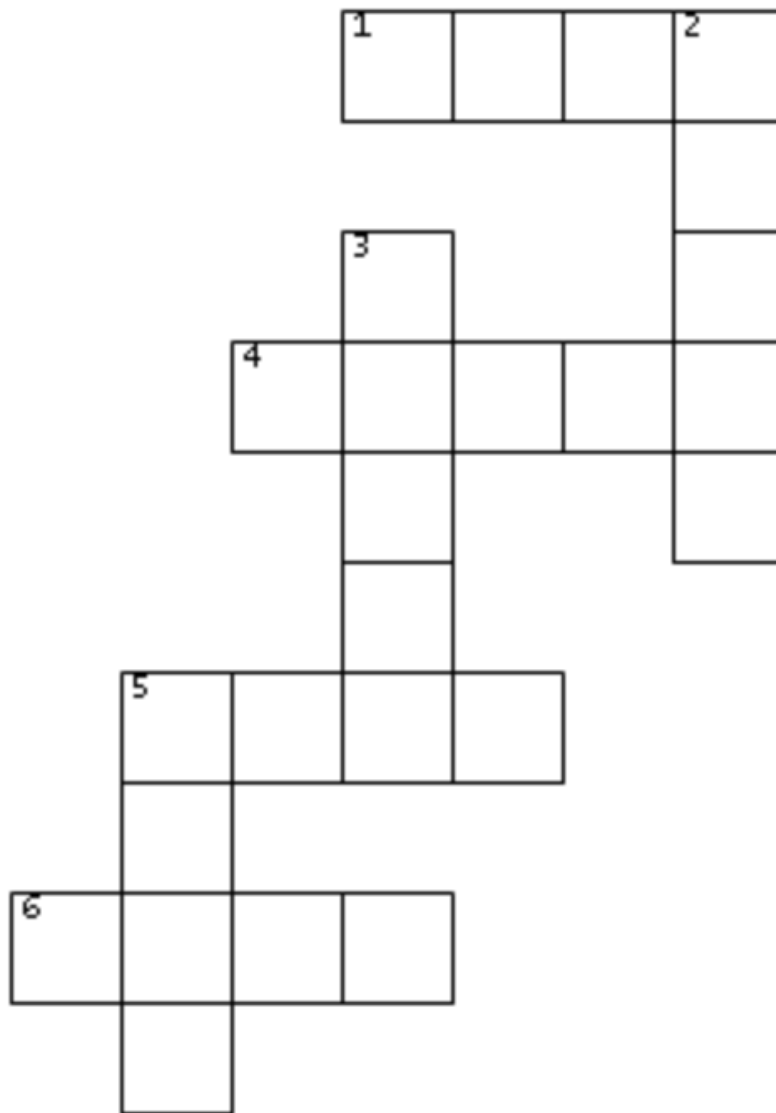
ACROSS

Transportation Crossword



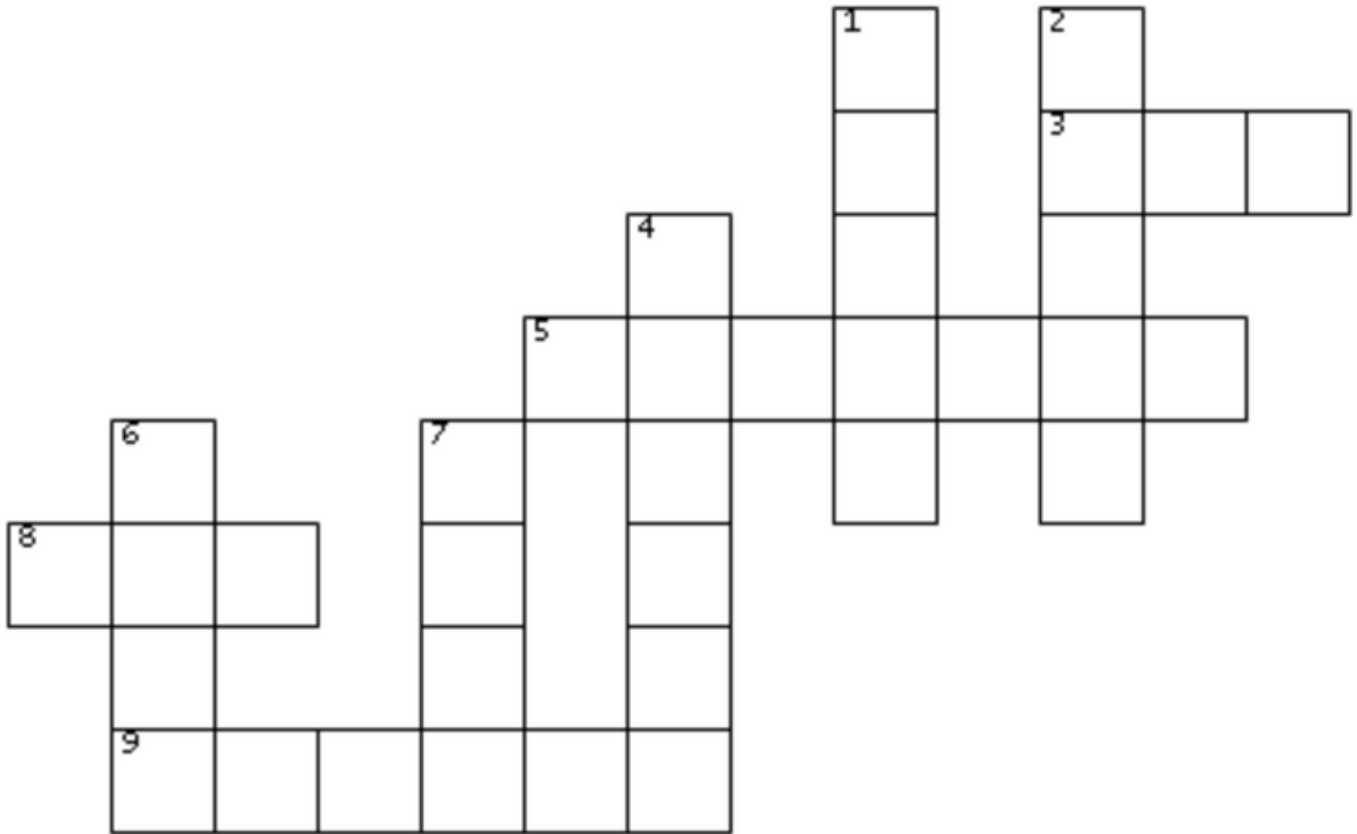
ACROSS

Farm Animals Crossword



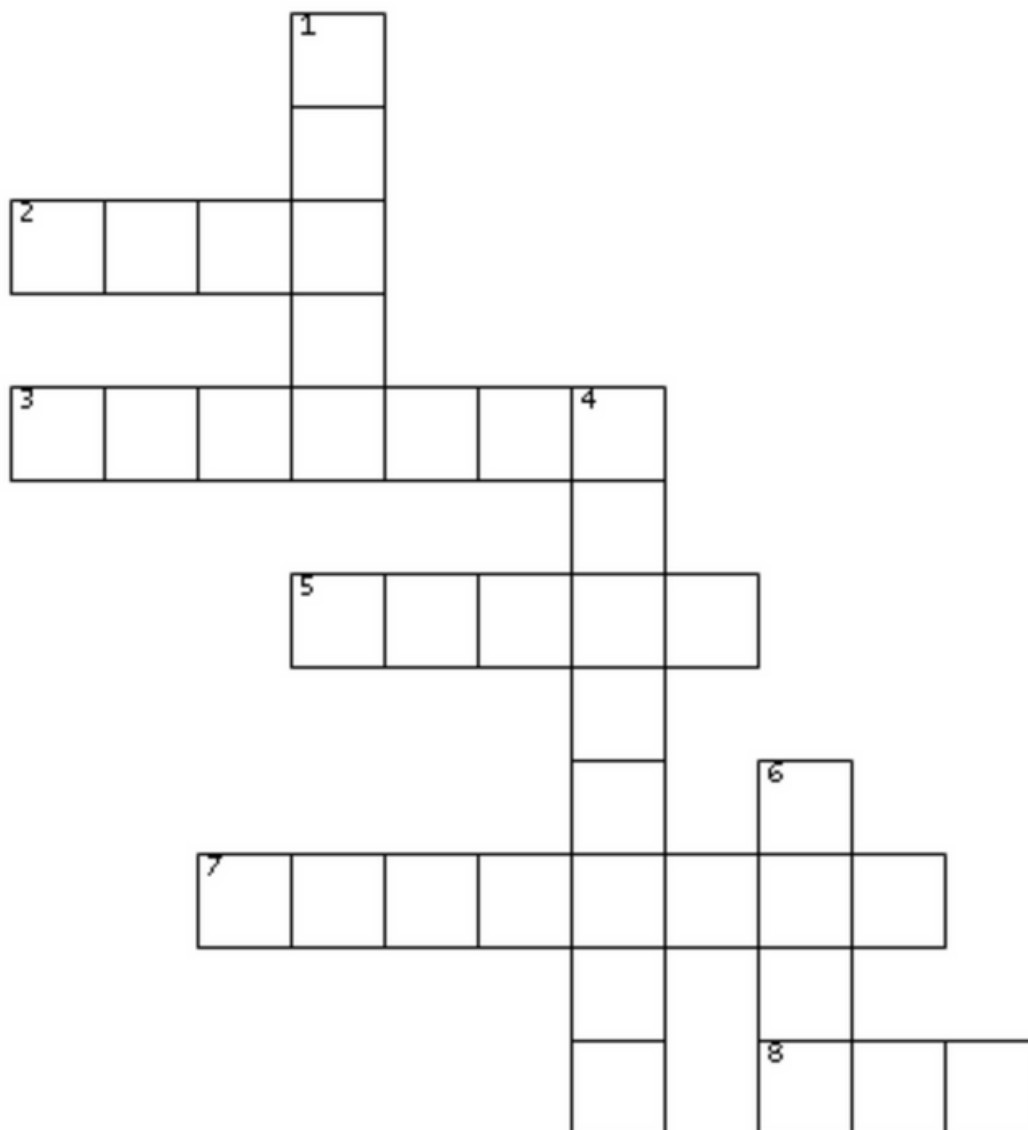

Wild Animals Crossword



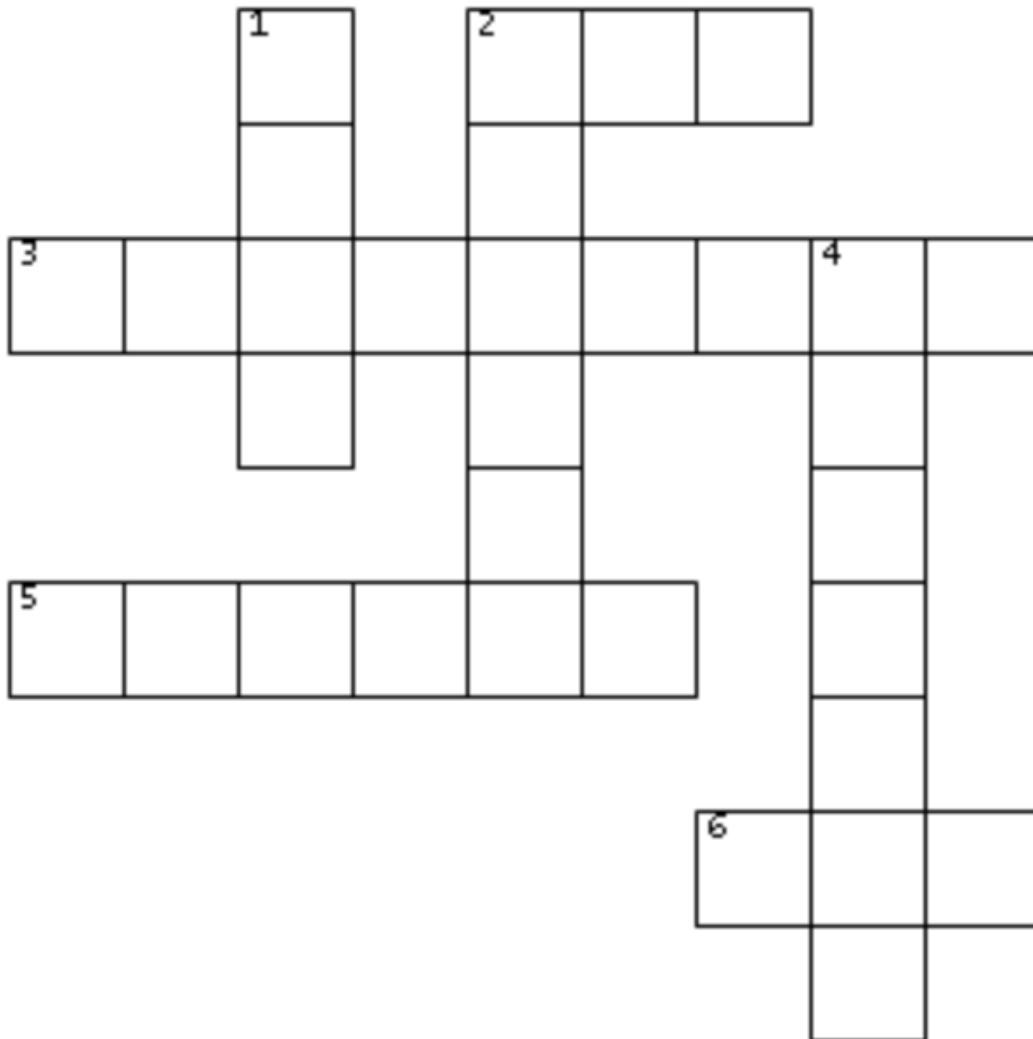

Insects Crossword



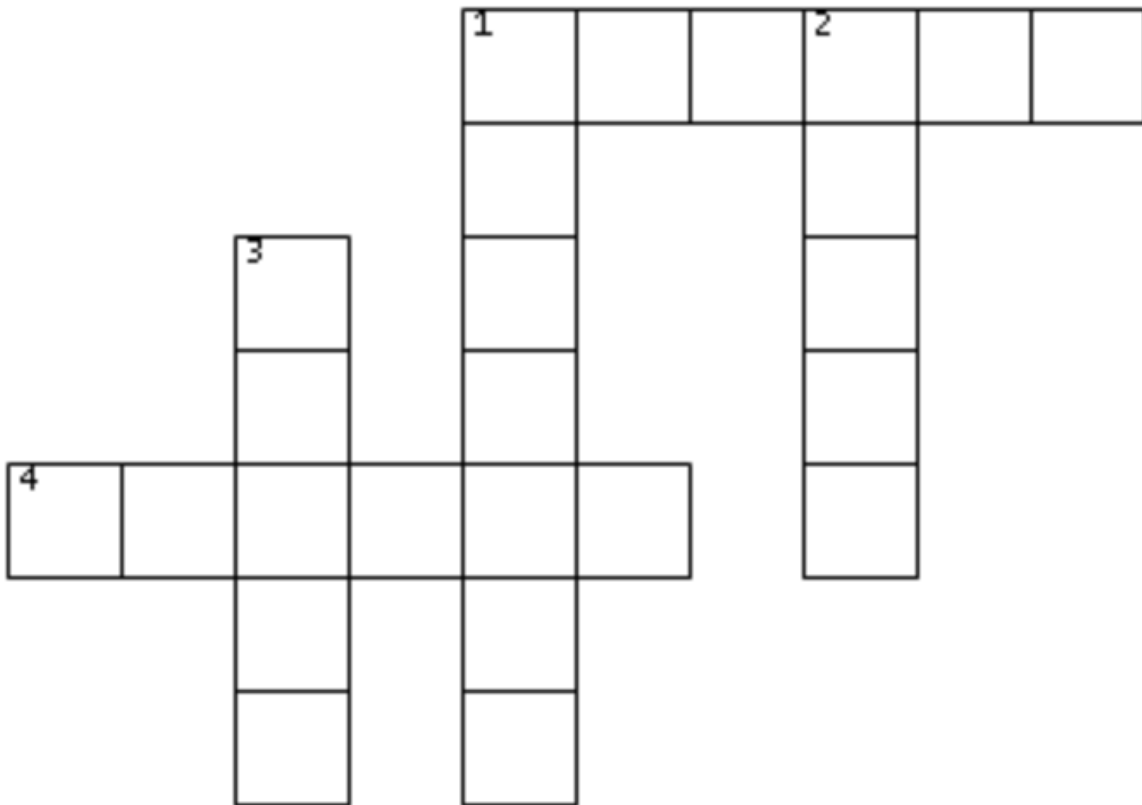
ACROSS

Birds Crossword



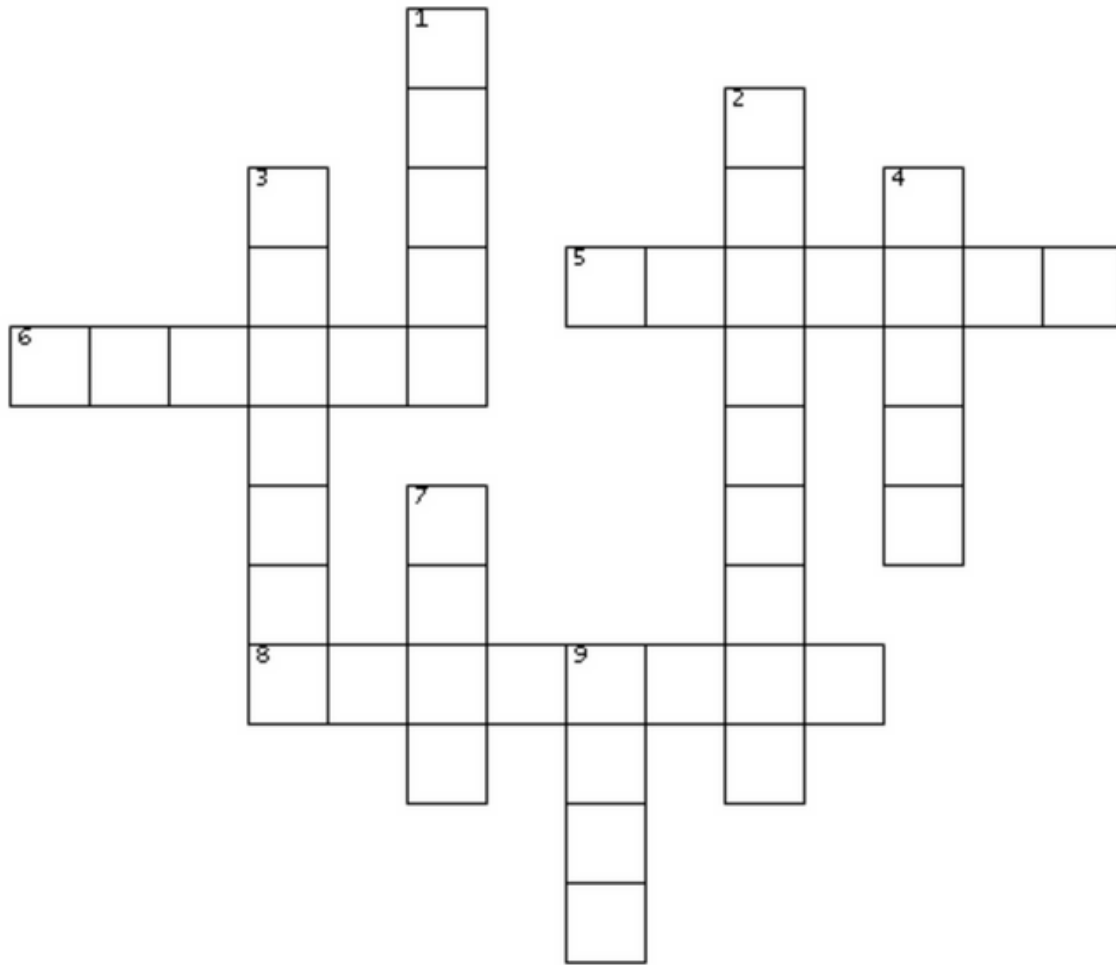
ACROSS

Sea Animals Crossword



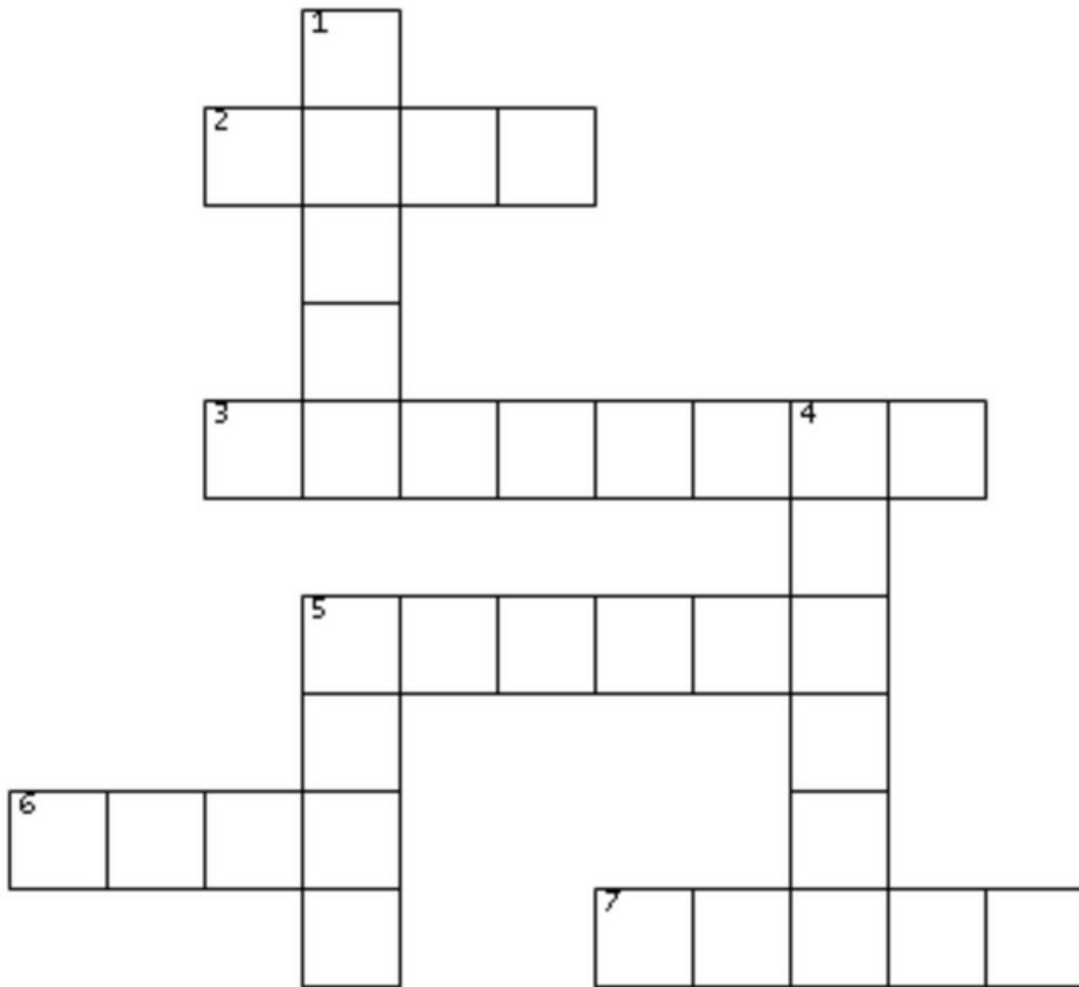
ACROSS

Food Crossword



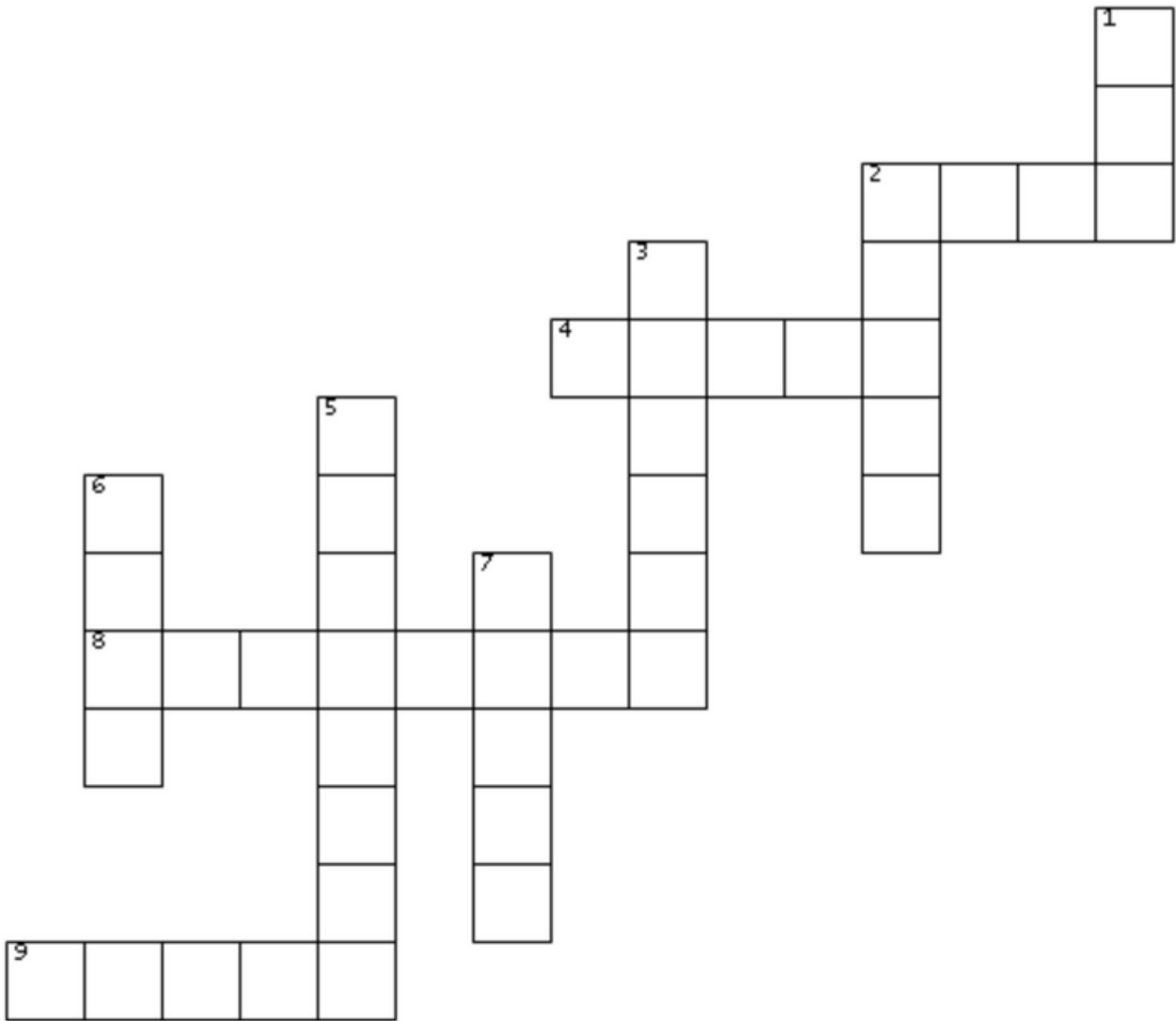

Drinks Crossword



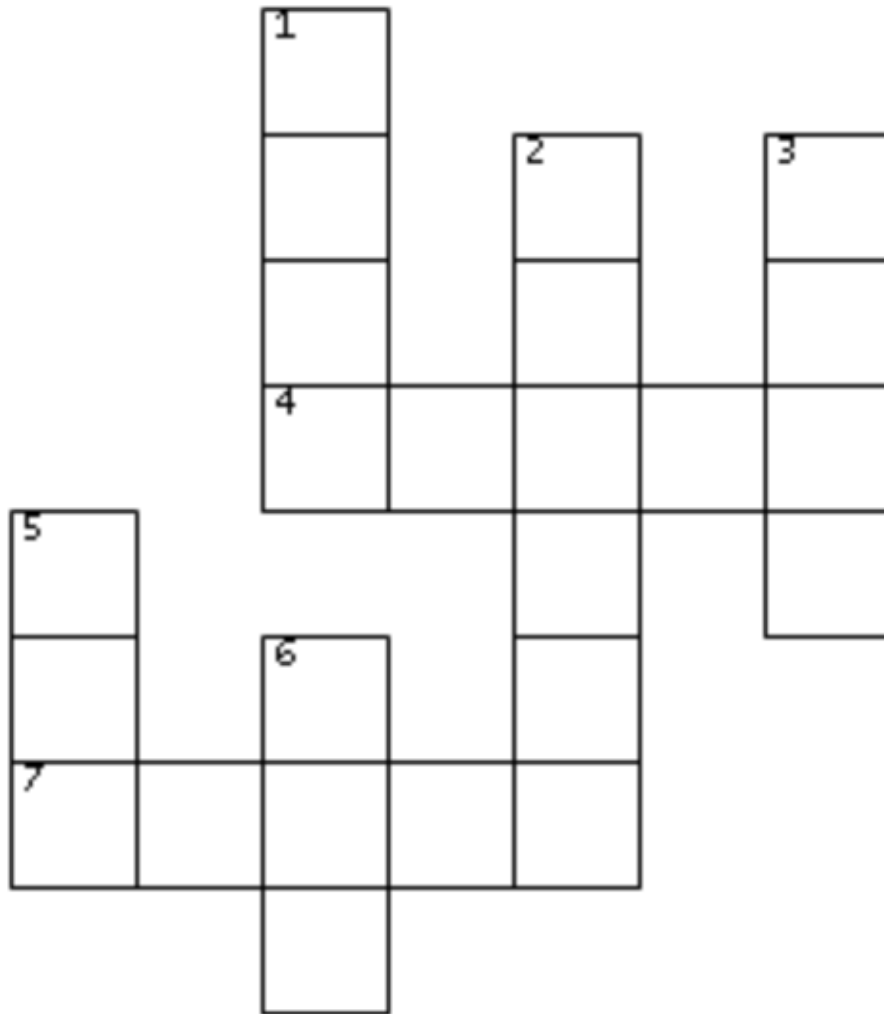
ACROSS

Kitchen Items Crossword



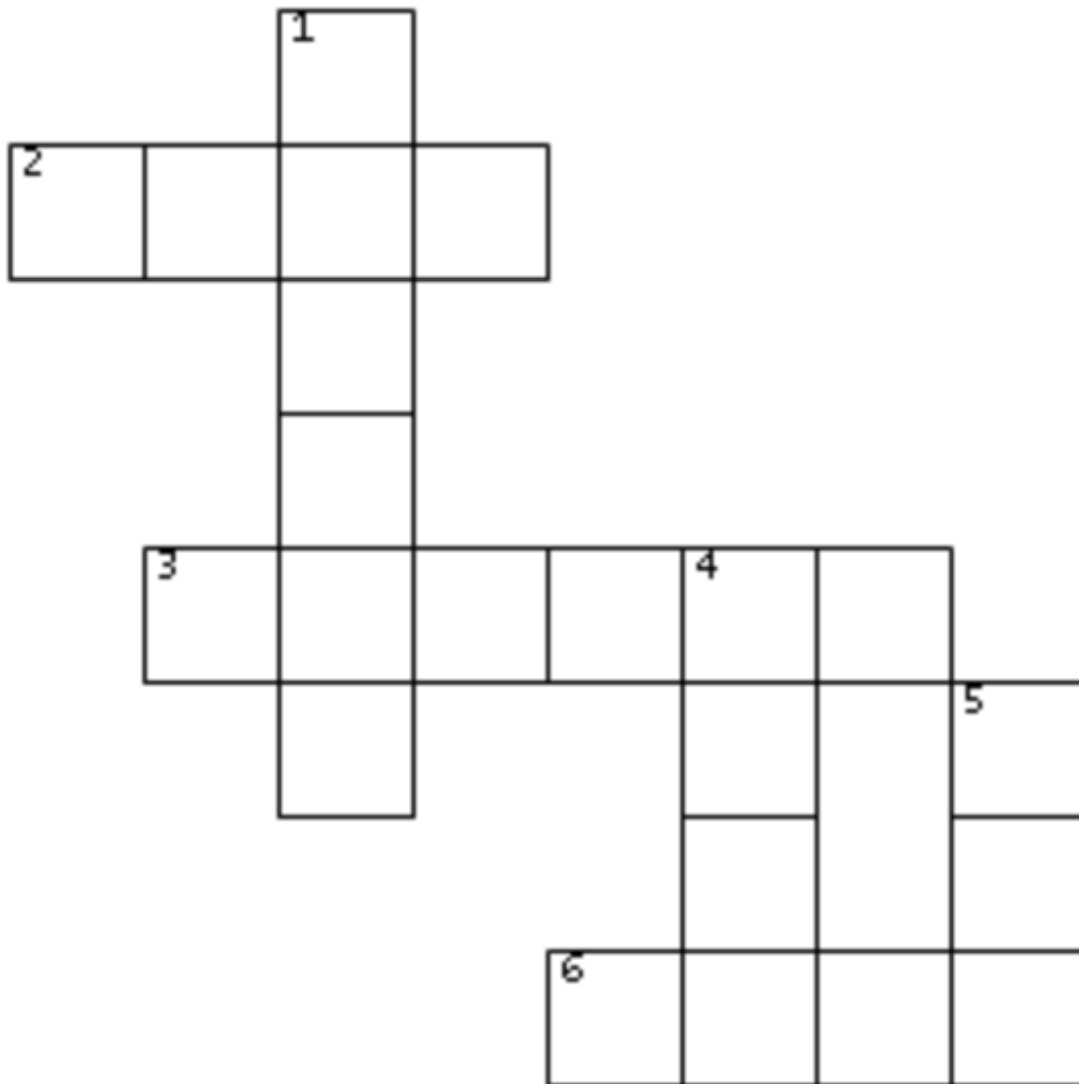
ACROSS

Toys Crossword



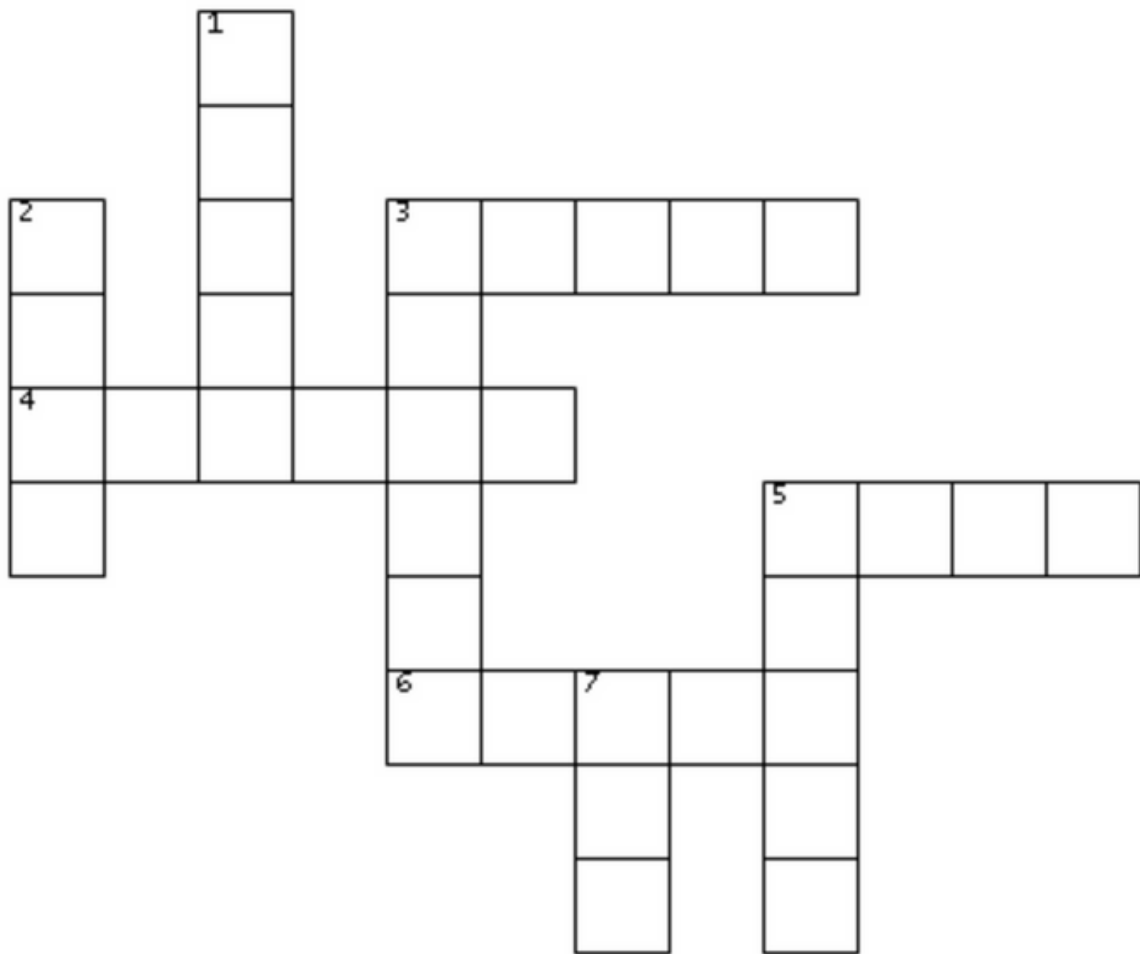
ACROSS

Furniture Crossword



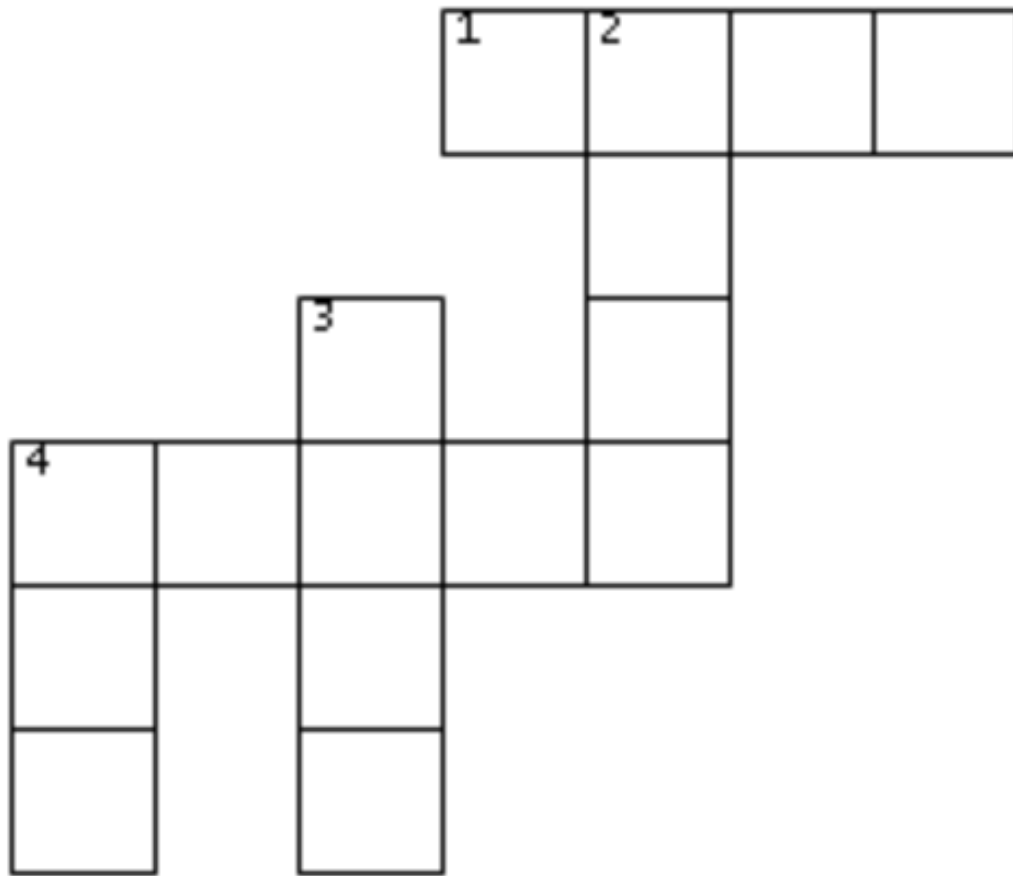
ACROSS

Actions Crossword



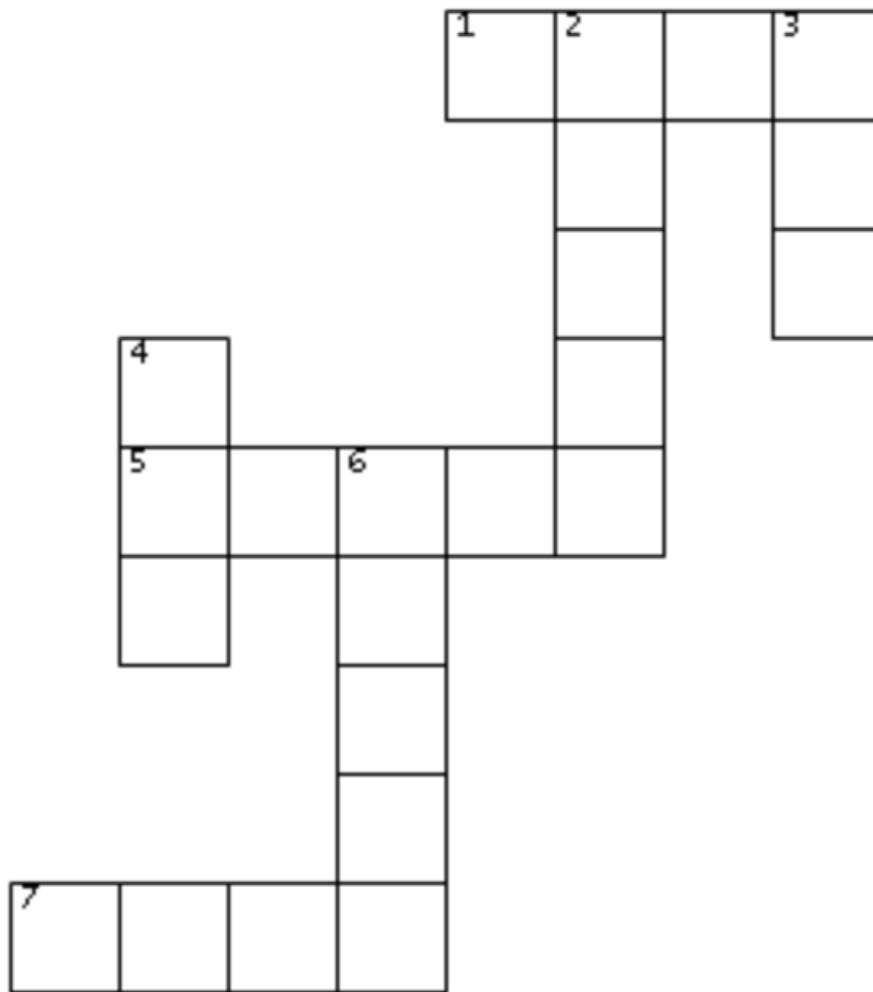

Feelings Crossword



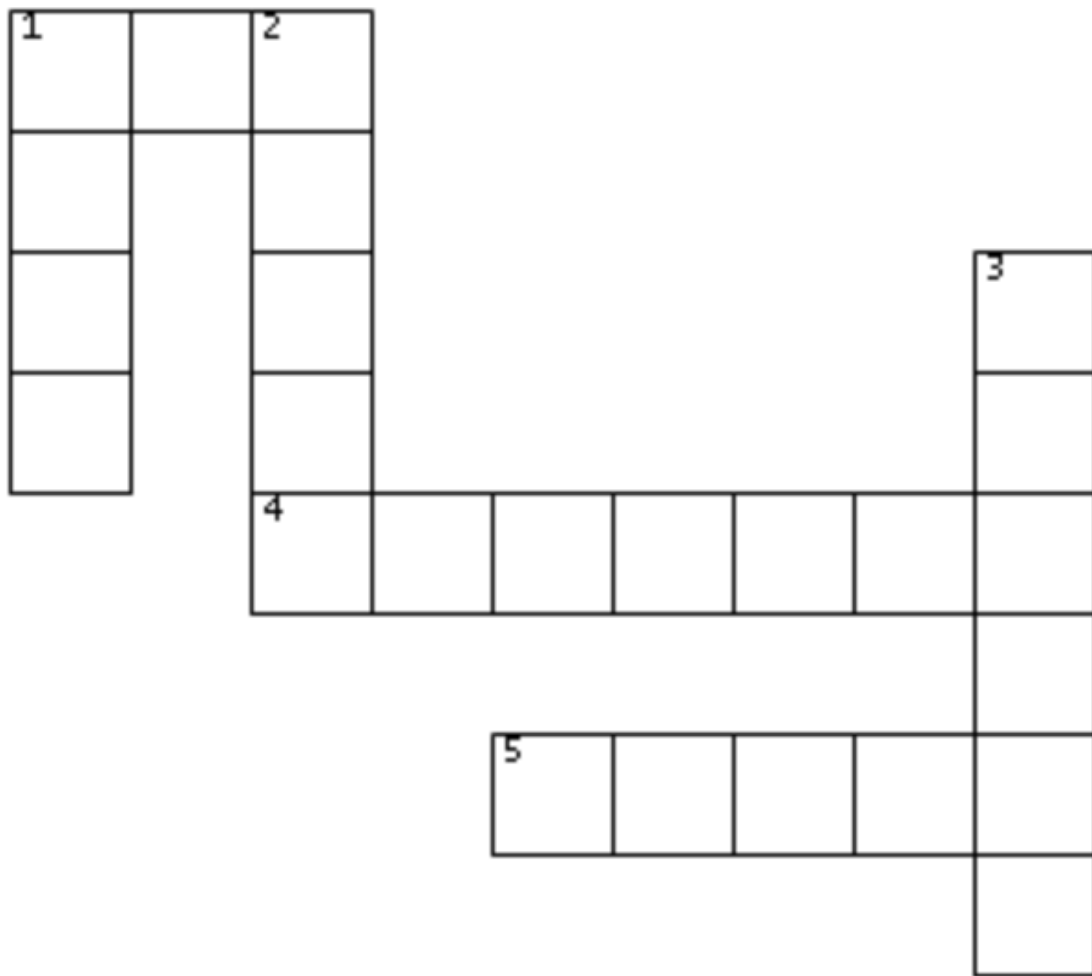

Jobs Crossword



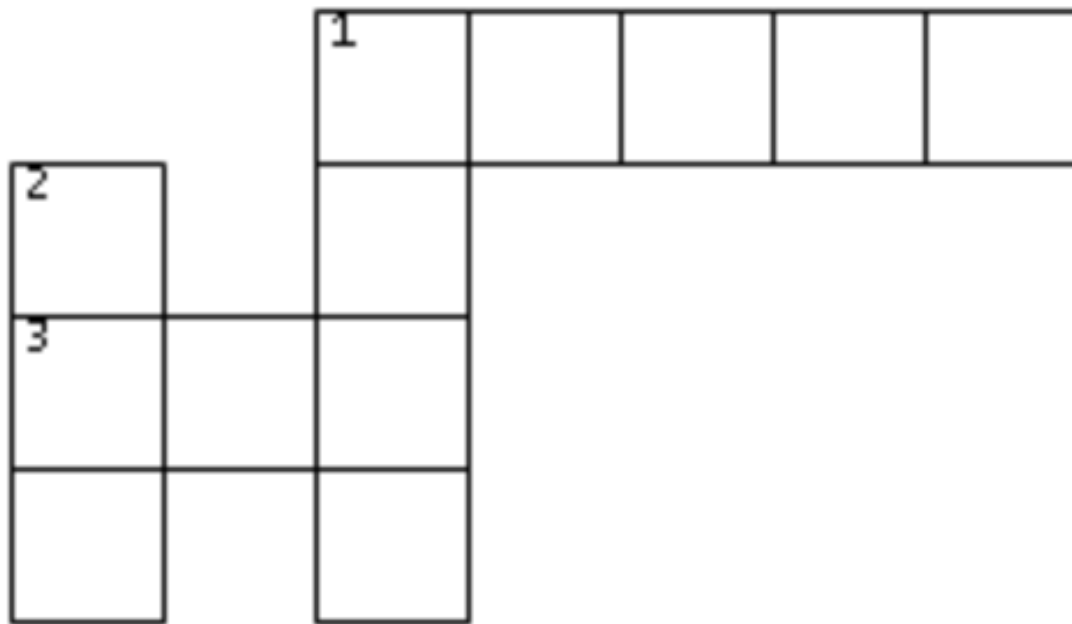

School Subjects Crossword



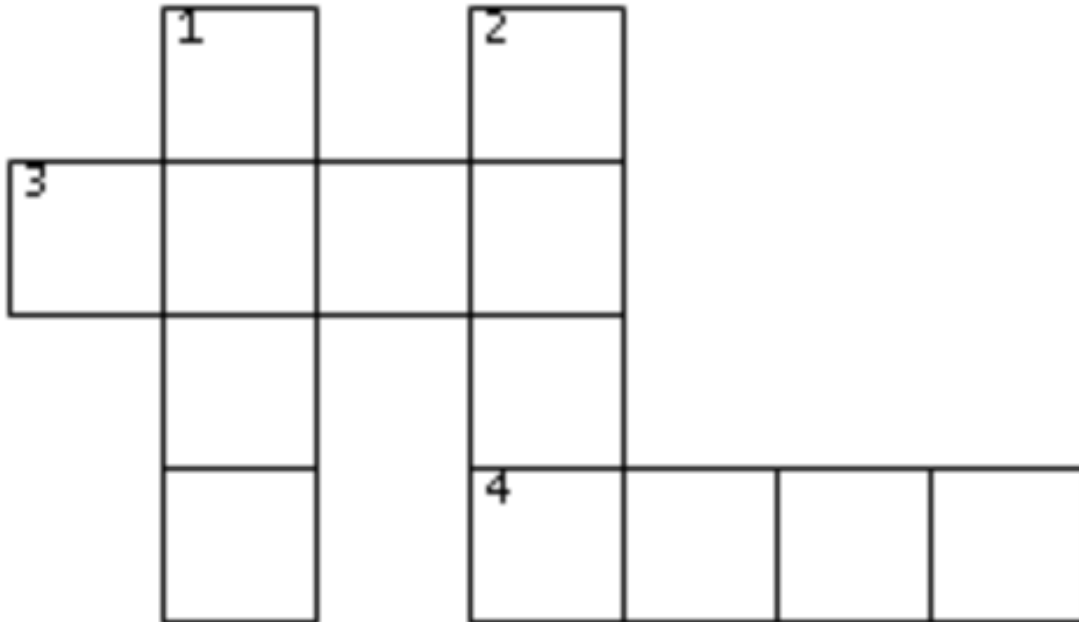
ACROSS
